FORENSIC ENGINEERING/HURRICANE DAMAGE INVESTIGATIONS

Our results were then presented to Forensic accountants and Adjusters acting on behalf of Insurers. Engineering data was used as an important negotiating factor in the settlement of the insurance claim.
